

### Keir Starmer: No Immediate Plan to Join Bluesky

### **Description**

Sir Keir Starmer says he won't join Bluesky, a new social media app. It's getting popular, especially after the US election. Even though many are leaving X, Sir Keir has no plans to use Bluesky yet. Bluesky was started by Jack Dorsey from Twitter in 2019. It's different because it's decentralized, not controlled by a single company. It has over 19 million users now. Some new users joined Bluesky because they don't want to support Musk, who supported Trump. The Guardian won't post on X anymore because they worry Musk can influence politics there.
