



King Charles III Meets Harry and Meghan at Highgrove

Description

King Charles III met with Prince Harry and his family at Highgrove House on Friday. This meeting is important as it is the first time they have gathered since Harry stepped back from royal duties and moved to California.

During the visit, Harry brought his wife, Meghan Markle, and their two children, Archie and Lilibet. The purpose of the meeting was to mend their family relationships, which have faced challenges over the years. Royal insiders have said that both the palace and the Sussexes wish to keep the details of this meeting private.

British broadcaster Helena Chard noted that King Charles is eager to see his grandchildren, especially as he undergoes cancer treatment. Royal experts indicated that the meeting lasted just over an hour and that Queen Camilla was also present to support her husband.

Notably absent from this gathering were Prince William and Kate Middleton, who were at a polo match. Sources say William remains distrustful of Harry, causing tension between the brothers.

The reunion is seen as a small but positive step forward, though it doesn't resolve all family issues. Future communication between Harry and his father may continue if Harry respects the family's privacy. The reunion comes after Harry expressed his desire to reconcile with his family.
