

Leaked Photo Reveals iPhone 17 Air with Rear Camera Bar

Anticipation looms surrounding the purported elongated camera bump slated for both the "iPhone 17 Air" and iPhone 17 Pro iterations, hinting at a potential design overhaul across the entire iPhone 17 range. Apple is primed to unveil the iPhone 17, "iPhone 17 Air," iPhone 17 Pro, and iPhone 17 Pro Max this September.

Echoing insights from Apple analyst Ming-Chi Kuo, the "iPhone 17 Air" is projected to measure a mere 5.5mm at its slimmest juncture, thereby paving the way for it to become the thinnest iPhone iteration to date. Notably, Apple refrains from incorporating the rear camera bump in its official iPhone dimensions. Owing to its slender profile, the "iPhone 17 Air" is anticipated to feature modest specifications, encompassing a lone rear camera, a solitary speaker, a universal absence of a SIM card slot, and an A19 chip as opposed to the more robust A19 Pro variant. Furthermore, the device is likely to house a diminished battery capacity relative to its counterparts due to spatial constraints.

Additional rumored attributes comprise a 6.6-inch OLED display augmented with a Dynamic Island, Face ID functionality, 8GB of RAM tailored for Apple Intelligence support, among other enhancements.
