



Mark Rylance in Talks to Play Dumbledore in 'Harry Potter' Series

Description

According to sources familiar with the project, renowned actor Mark Rylance has emerged as a leading contender for a prominent role in the upcoming HBO adaptation of "Harry Potter," as reported by *Variety*.

Currently captivating audiences as Thomas Cromwell in the highly-anticipated BBC drama "Wolf Hall: The Mirror and The Light," Rylance is reportedly being considered for the role of Dumbledore. Insider information suggests that discussions are underway regarding his potential involvement.

While it has not yet entered formal negotiations, Warner Bros. Television has made initial inquiries to assess Rylance's interest and availability. Representatives for Rylance have not immediately commented, and an HBO spokesperson stated, "We recognize that a high-profile series like this will naturally generate rumors and speculation. The HBO series, which was first announced in 2023, is expected to provide a more detailed exploration of the beloved series and is scheduled to premiere in 2026.
