

## Maximizing Personalized Ads: Meta's Data Limitation Strategy

### **Description**

The EU's top court says Facebook-owner Meta must use less of people's data for personalized ads. A campaigner, Max Schrems, complained that Facebook used his personal data without permission, like his sexuality, to target ads at him. The court ruled in his favor. It said Facebook cannot use sensitive data like sexual orientation for targeted ads without restrictions. Meta says it doesn't use special category data for ads and takes privacy seriously. Users can manage their data settings. Experts say the court's decision will affect Meta's business model. Similar challenges might happen in other countries. Mr. Schrems has taken Meta to court multiple times. The EU court's decision is not binding for the UK but could still have big consequences. The Austrian Supreme Court will give its final decision soon.
