Captured by Prince Harry, she was portrayed in a flowing white linen ensemble, effortlessly traversing the beach adjacent to their residence in Montecito, California, as per a report by [People magazine](#).

The post, devoid of any caption, featured her etching “2025” into the sand before frolicking exuberantly through the scene.

Remarkably, within hours of her return, the Duchess had garnered over 400,000 followers on her new Instagram account.

Initially, following their marriage, Markle and Harry belonged to the @KensingtonRoyal account, also co-managed by Prince William and Kate Middleton. After one year, they established the @SussexRoyal account, which was ultimately deactivated in 2020 when the couple distanced themselves from royal duties and relocated to California.
