



## Men on Tiktok Say BBLs Stink but Women Explain Why

### Description

There seems to be a concern about Brazilian Butt Lifts (BBLs) that needs to be highlighted. People are claiming that a person might have an unpleasant smell after getting a BBL. Some men have shared online their experiences with their female partners who have BBLs and complained about the odor.

The situation was further clarified by a plastic surgeon who uses the handle @DrRogerTsai. He confirmed that cleaning can indeed become more difficult after a BBL as there is simply more area to reach.

Given the popularity of the procedure - over 21,000 were carried out in 2020 according to the Cleveland Clinic - this topic is gaining importance. The online community not only brought to light the possible issues but also offered helpful ways to combat them. One such solution includes using homemade soap with natural ingredients to curb bad odors. However, the most effective suggestion seems to be to get a bidet, as it can be life-changing for those struggling with hygiene after a BBL.
