

Michaela DePrince, groundbreaking ballerina, passes away at 29

Description

The passing of Michaela DePrince, a ballet icon and humanitarian who overcame a traumatic childhood, was announced on her Instagram page at the age of 29. Born Mabinty Bangura in Sierra Leone, she endured mistreatment, malnourishment, and vitiligo at the orphanage where she grew up. Forced to flee to a refugee camp due to impending danger, DePrince was eventually adopted by a couple from New Jersey and moved to the United States at the age of 4.

Despite her challenging past, DePrince found solace and inspiration in dance, eventually training at prestigious ballet schools and making a name for herself in the dance world. She faced racial discrimination along the way, but her determination was unwavering. DePrince's career soared as she became the youngest principal dancer at the Dance Theatre of Harlem and joined the Dutch National Ballet, breaking new ground and inspiring many.

Outside of dance, DePrince was a passionate advocate for children affected by conflict and violence, serving as an ambassador for War Child Holland. Her life was characterized by grace, purpose, and strength, leaving a lasting impact on those around her.
