Michelle Pfeiffer and her husband David E. Kelley are teaming up for the first time in over three decades.

Pfeiffer decided to break her rule of keeping her personal and professional lives separate to star in "Margo's Got Money Troubles" for AppleTV+.

Sharing the news on Instagram, Pfeiffer expressed her excitement about working alongside Elle Fanning, Nicole Kidman, and Kelley's production company.

Despite being married for years, Pfeiffer and Kelley had previously avoided working together due to the perceived risks. However, they decided to collaborate on this project in 2025.
