



Musk's AI Power Plant Breaches Clean Air Regulations, Drone Footage Reveals

Description

Elon Musk's artificial intelligence company, xAI, is using gas turbines at its facility in Southaven, Mississippi, without the necessary permits. An investigation by Floodlight, an independent newsroom, revealed that xAI continues to burn gas despite a ruling from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This ruling states that a permit is required for such activities.

In Mississippi, state regulators argue that the turbines do not need permits because they are on trailers. However, the EPA insists that these turbines must have permits according to the Clean Air Act. Experts confirm that some turbines are producing harmful emissions at the site nearly two weeks after the EPA's announcement.

Bruce Buckheit, a former EPA official, stated that operating without permission is illegal. xAI is currently applying for permits for additional turbines. The EPA has not provided comments on this issue but has referred questions to local authorities.

The public is concerned about the noise and pollution from the site, which is near many schools. Residents feel that their health is at risk, with pollutants linked to issues like asthma and heart problems.

As xAI expands its operations, the debate over its emissions and their impact on the community continues, with many advocating for stricter regulation of AI facilities.
