


Must-Read Sci-Fi Releases: Murakami and Ellison This Month

Description









Haruki Murakami has a long-awaited new novel out in English translation this month

Anticipation has been building for the English translation of Haruki Murakami's latest offering, *The City and Its Uncertain Walls*, which became available just in time for Christmas. This novel promises to be a captivating blend of dreamlike elements and speculative themes. November also introduces an intriguing culinary contest set in space—*Interstellar MegaChef* by Lavanya Lakshminarayan—sure to tantalize readers' taste buds. However, the month's highlight rests in its short story collections: a long-anticipated sci-fi anthology spearheaded by the legendary Harlan Ellison, alongside a debut from the talented Eliza Clark. For those who have been too busy to read a full-length novel, these collections provide perfect opportunities for literary escapism.

Originally published as a story in 1980, Murakami returns to his universe, exploring a man's quest to find his vanished girlfriend and the metaphorical "walled city" where her true self dwells. Murakami expresses that amid profound societal shifts, the question of whether to stay within the walls or venture beyond holds unprecedented significance.

Another noteworthy release is Ellison's anthology, finally bringing to light powerful pieces from diverse authors that explore a multitude of themes in sci-fi. Enthusiasts of speculative fiction will find a wealth of excitement in this month's offerings, ensuring a delightful reading experience.
