



NBC reduces 'Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon' to 4 nights.

Description

NBC has decided to scale back "The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon" to four nights a week, a change that reflects the network's cost-cutting measures in the face of declining ratings. Starting soon, the show will no longer air on Fridays, instead showing reruns. While NBC has not provided a specific reason for the reduction, it comes in the wake of a broader examination of late-night programming expenses.

The adjustment has raised questions about Jimmy Fallon's hefty annual salary, estimated at \$16 million. It remains unclear whether this change will impact his earnings. This move follows NBC's recent decision to drop the house band from "Late Night with Seth Meyers," with the network citing financial constraints as the driving factor.

Late-night shows on other networks, such as CBS and ABC, have already transitioned to airing four nights a week, and their hosts also command significant salaries. Despite the challenges posed by streaming services, networks are still investing heavily in late-night programming.

While the future of late-night TV remains uncertain, one thing is clear: the landscape is evolving rapidly, and host salaries continue to be a topic of interest. Jimmy Fallon, alongside his counterparts on competing networks, is set to navigate these changes as he continues to host "The Tonight Show" for years to come.
