



New Elon Musk revelations: Lawsuits won't lead to AGI

Description

The legal fight between Elon Musk and OpenAI is getting more intense. OpenAI released a post defending itself against Musk with new text messages from co-founders like Ilya Sutskever, Greg Brockman, and others.

Musk then started a rival company called xAI after disagreements with OpenAI co-founders. Messages revealed Musk's concerns about OpenAI's valuation and his financial contributions.

The messages were mentioned in Musk's lawsuit against OpenAI and Microsoft, alleging a shift from OpenAI's original nonprofit mission. OpenAI's recent update challenges Musk's claims about power struggles within the company, aiming to shift the narrative in their favor.
