

New Hampshire Lights Up with Stunning Northern Aurora Display

Description

Granite Staters in New Hampshire were in for a treat as they eagerly awaited the Perseid meteor shower, only to be surprised by a spectacular show of the northern lights. Many residents, like Kristin Noble from Bedford, set their alarms for 2 a.m. to view the meteor shower but were greeted by the mesmerizing display of the northern lights instead.

Logan Lambert, another local resident from the Upper Valley, managed to capture a stunning photo of the northern lights alongside a shooting star. This extraordinary sight was made possible by a G2-level solar storm that occurred over the weekend due to coronal mass ejections heading towards Earth, resulting in the captivating auroras.

With a G3 solar storm observed on Monday, there is a possibility of more northern lights sightings throughout the week. No special equipment is needed to witness this natural phenomenon, as smartphones can capture the faint lights better than the human eye. Simply point your camera towards the clear night sky between 10 p.m. and 2 a.m., away from city lights, and look north for a chance to witness the enchanting aurora borealis. Explore the beauty of the night sky and marvel at the wonders of nature.
