

Novocaine Wins Opening Day Battle Over 'Mickey 17'

Description

Movie theaters have been quiet lately, with 2025 shaping up to be a slow year for the film industry. This weekend, despite the release of two new movies - "Novocaine" and "Black Bag" - it looks like box office numbers will be lower than usual. The last time this happened was back in February 2024.
