



## Oscar Voter Ballot Reveals Choices for 'One Battle' and DiCaprio

### Description

Several Academy Awards voters have shared their selections for the 2026 Oscars, revealing their choices and reasons behind them. The polls closed on 5 March at 5 p.m. PT, prompting voters to disclose their picks.

One voter expressed a strong preference for "One Battle After Another" as their top choice for Best Picture. They praised its epic storytelling and described it as a standout film of the year, surpassing their previous favourite, "The Brutalist." They placed "Sinners" in second and "Sentimental Value" in third.

In the Best Director category, the same voter chose Paul Thomas Anderson for "One Battle After Another," highlighting his exceptional storytelling ability. They noted that Anderson has consistently produced great work over the years, beginning with "Boogie Nights."

For Best Actress, they selected Jessie Buckley for her performance in "Hamnet," citing her outstanding role despite strong competition, particularly from Emma Stone in "Bugonia." The voter felt Buckley was notably superior.

Leonardo DiCaprio was their pick for Best Actor for "One Battle After Another," with the voter calling it possibly the film of the year or even the decade.

In the Best Supporting Actress category, Teyana Taylor was noted for an iconic role in "One Battle After Another." For Best Supporting Actor, the voter suggested Stellan Skarsgård in "Sentimental Value," although they initially thought Sean Penn would win.

Finally, "One Battle After Another" was again highlighted as Best Adapted Screenplay, commending its political commentary and genre blending. The voter concluded with "Sinners" being their choice for Best Original Screenplay due to its inventiveness.
