
Overview of Pokémon Champions Regulation M-B Double Battles

Description

Since the launch of Pokémon Champions and Regulation M-A, several Pokémon have emerged as key players in competitive matches, greatly influencing the game's landscape. Their distinct abilities limit the variety of viable competitors.

Sneasler made a significant impact early on, and while its popularity has decreased somewhat, it remains crucial in the current format. Its moves, Dire Claw and Close Combat, offer effective strategies against many opponents, while Fake Out provides vital support for other Pokémon.

Garchomp is another standout in this tournament scene, consistently dominating play. It competes with Basculegion and Kingambit for the title of the most-used Pokémon. Garchomp excels as the best Ground-type option, effectively countering Charizard with its Rock-type moves and resistance to Heat Wave.

The most effective item for Garchomp is Life Orb, which amplifies its damage. Before Life Orb's introduction, Garchomp struggled to defeat bulky Mega Charizard Y independently. This item now allows Garchomp to achieve significant knockouts.

Basculegion challenges Garchomp's supremacy by offering late-game momentum with its powerful move, Last Respects. Initially weak, this move grows stronger with each defeated teammate, potentially reaching a base power of 400. Its Adaptability Ability enhances its same-type moves, making it a formidable opponent.

Kingambit has established itself as the best Steel type in the game, primarily due to its effectiveness against Basculegion. Its move Sucker Punch inflicts substantial damage, particularly against faster competitors. While it has a limited move choice, its core abilities remain crucial.

Finally, Incineroar, although initially less popular, is regaining traction. Its unique combination of Fire and Dark types, along with its Intimidate ability, enhances the performance of many Mega-Evolved Pokémon. Its role in competitive play is likely to increase as new Pokémon are introduced to the format.
