



Perry Farrell's Onstage Clash with Dave Navarro at Jane's Addiction Concert

Description

The highly anticipated Jane's Addiction concert in Boston took an unexpected turn when singer Perry Farrell physically attacked guitarist Dave Navarro on stage during their performance of "Ocean Size." Video footage captured Farrell aggressively confronting Navarro before ultimately throwing a punch at him, leading to a chaotic and abrupt end to the show.
