## Playing Wolfenstein 3D One-Handed in 2026

### Description

The game "Wolfenstein 3D" has some problems with difficulty levels. The easiest level is called "Can I Play, Daddy." It is very simple for people who know first-person shooter (FPS) games. The enemies are slow and do not hurt you much. The normal level, "Bring 'em On!" can feel unfair. Some enemies can take away a lot of your health quickly.

There are new enemies in the game, but they are not very exciting. After many levels, players want new weapons. However, the new weapons feel too similar to old ones.

The game uses a score system, like many arcade games. Players have a limited number of lives. Losing a life means you lose your weapons. But you can save the game anytime, which makes the lives less important. When you finish an episode, you have to start a new game with no connection to the previous one.

On a positive note, the game works well with a mouse. Players can control it one-handed without using the keyboard. This makes it easier to aim and play.
