Description

Pokémon GO is celebrating its 10th anniversary with the introduction of Mega Mewtwo X and Mega Mewtwo Y in Super Mega Raid Battles. Trainers will need to collaborate to defeat these formidable Raid Bosses. For the first time, Pokémon GO Fest 2026: Global will be completely free for all players who log in during the event weekend, providing special research tasks, extra bonuses, and a higher chance to find Shiny Pokémon at no cost.

Players can join their local communities to team up against the powerful Mega Raids or participate in 26 Community Celebrations worldwide during Pokémon GO Fest 2026: Global. These celebrations will occur in major cities, offering free public events featuring a fully branded Pokémon GO experience filled with on-site adventures and special giveaways.

Local communities are essential for this GO Fest, and the event provides a great opportunity for Trainers to connect with one another. Planned events include pop-up activities and the chance to engage with Community Ambassadors, who will be available to guide attendees and host various activities.
