



Poll by CBS News reveals overwhelming support among Americans for U.S. efforts to combat climate change

Description

Extreme weather events like record heat, hurricanes, and wildfires are becoming increasingly common in recent years, capturing headlines worldwide. While there may be differing opinions on whether these events are directly linked to climate change, there is a clear consensus among a majority of Americans that the U.S. needs to take action to address this pressing issue.
