



Pooh Shiesty's Lawyer Responds to Gucci Mane Kidnapping Case

Description

Pooh Shiesty, a rapper from Memphis, faces serious legal trouble. His lawyer, John Helms, spoke about the case in an interview. Helms, who is based in Dallas, joined the case this week.
