



Powerball \$1.765 billion jackpot winner Theodorus Struyck revealed in California

A California resident, Theodorus Struyck, has become a billionaire overnight by winning Powerball's second largest jackpot, a hefty amount of \$1.765 billion. This monumental victory was announced five months after the lottery draw.

Living in a serene, mountain town of Frazier Park in California, Struyck is a respected 65-year-old resident who purchased the astronomical-lottery ticket from a local market.
