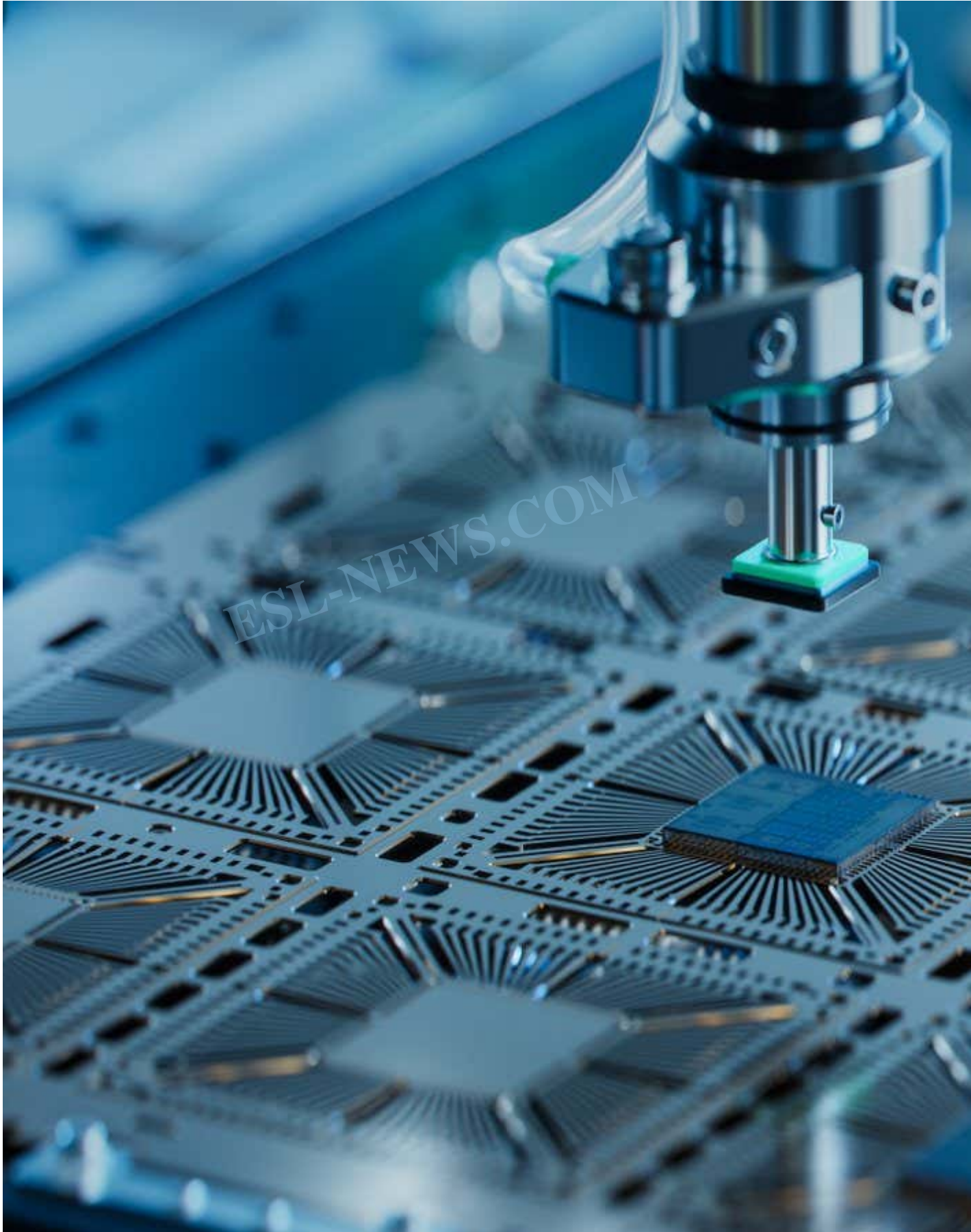




Powerful Hurricane Helene Threatens Semiconductor Production
