



# Princess Catherine of Wales makes first public appearance since cancer diagnosis, joining royals on palace balcony

## Description

Kate, the Princess of Wales, made her first public **appearance** since being **diagnosed** with cancer at the King's official birthday celebration in London. Joined by her husband William and their children, the royal family watched a Royal Air Force flypast from the **balcony** of Buckingham Palace.
