

Rapper Brother Marquis of 2 Live Crew Passes Away at 58

Description

Iconic rapper Brother Marquis, a member of the legendary rap group 2 Live Crew, has passed away at the age of 58, as confirmed by the group on social media. The New York native, whose real name was Mark D. Ross, joined the Miami hip-hop group in 1986 at the age of 19. The group's manager has verified the news to TMZ, stating that there is no suspicion of foul play in his death.

Brother Marquis, along with fellow rappers Uncle Luke, Fresh Kid Ice, and Mr. Mixx, rose to fame as hip-hop legends with their controversial 1989 album "As Nasty As They Wanna Be."
