

Rebel Wilson's book released in the UK with censored text by Sacha Baron Cohen

Description

The UK release of Rebel Wilson's autobiography includes redacted sections, specifically those relating to allegations against Sacha Baron Cohen. The US release earlier this month caused controversy due to these claims. The British edition has blacked out the contentious text, citing legal reasons in England and Wales. Both Wilson and Baron Cohen's spokespeople have commented on the redactions, with Baron Cohen's team calling it a "clear victory". HarperCollins, the publisher, stated that despite the redactions, they are excited for readers to learn Rebel's full story. Additional redactions in the British edition include shorter sections.

Critics in the UK have given poor reviews of the book, questioning the writing style and content. One reviewer mentioned the book containing weak jokes and self-indulgence, while another noted the diary entries felt like a lesser version of Bridget Jones. Despite the criticism, there was acknowledgment of Wilson's candidness and bravery in sharing her story. The overall reception of Rebel Rising has been mixed, with some critics finding it engaging for fans of Wilson but less compelling for other readers.
