



Review of Crow Country on the PS5 by Push Square

Description

Survival horror adventure game, Crow Country, developed by SFB Games, follows the story of Mara Forest, a determined young woman searching for the missing Edward Crow, owner of the closed Crow Country amusement park. The game features a retro graphical style reminiscent of classic PS1 titles like Resident Evil and Silent Hill, with added detail and depth in the environments. However, the high level of detail can sometimes make it difficult to distinguish interactive items, especially in dimly lit areas, intensifying the horror experience.

Despite its 90s aesthetics, Crow Country offers modern comfort and playability with controls similar to classic Resident Evil games, along with an option for a more contemporary control scheme. The game includes quality of life features such as adjustable difficulty levels, including an "exploration" mode that eliminates enemy encounters for a more relaxed gameplay experience. The creature design is praised for its balance of grotesque and menacing, elevating the intensity of enemy encounters.

With a haunting soundtrack featuring eerie ambient tracks and intense combat music, Crow Country successfully sets the mood for a chilling gameplay experience. SFB Games has achieved a remarkable feat with Crow Country, delivering a nostalgic yet innovative horror game that will particularly appeal to fans of 90s classics like Resident Evil.
