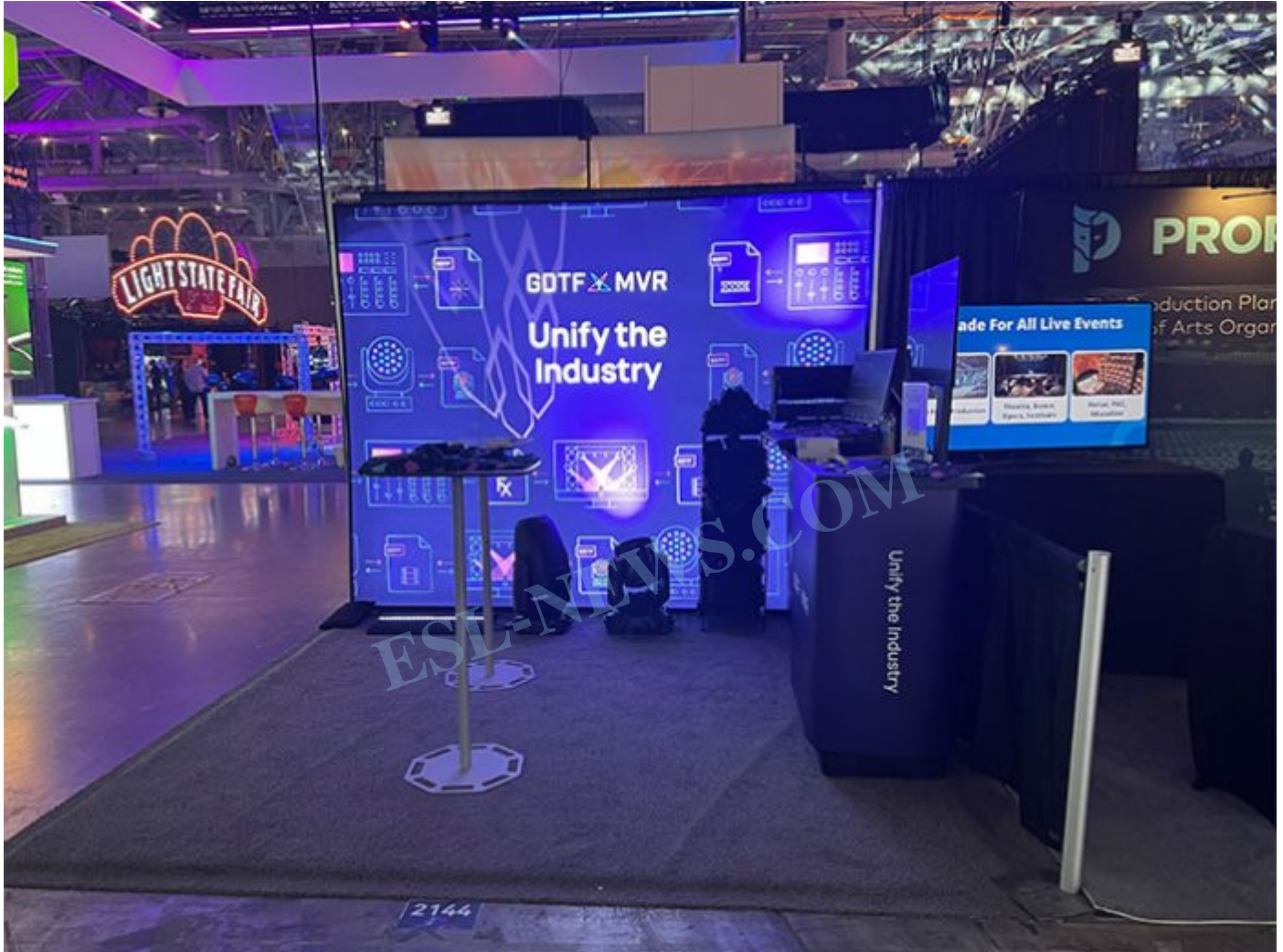


Revolutionizing Live Entertainment: Unveiling GDTF and MVR Benefits
