4. **resolution** /,rez.ə'lju:ʃən/ (noun): The number of distinct pixels on a display usually given as width × height (e.g. 2304×1440); it determines image detail.
5. **refresh rate** /rɪ'freʃ reɪt/ (noun phrase): How many times per second a display updates its image measured in hertz (Hz); higher rates produce smoother motion.
6. **enthusiasts** /ɪn'θju:zi.æsts/ (noun (plural)): People who have a strong interest and specialized knowledge about a particular hobby or subject (here: technology/gaming).
