



Rolling Stones rock MetLife Stadium before Memorial Day weekend

Description

The Rolling Stones rocked the crowd at MetLife Stadium in East Rutherford, New Jersey on May 23. With members Mick Jagger and Keith Richards, both in their 80s, the band showed they can still deliver a high-energy performance.
