

# Ryan Reynolds Claps Back at Martha Stewart's 'Not Funny' Remarks

### **Description**

With a glint of humor, she remarked, "Maybe he can get to be funny again ... I'm going to get in trouble," evidencing no malice in her characterizations of Reynolds. Their rapport spans over a decade, originating when Reynolds and his wife, Blake Lively, 37, acquired a property in close proximity to Stewart's Bedford, NY estate.

In a prior interview concerning their relationship, Stewart expressed her fondness for the couple, affirming them as "very friendly, very nice people," and noting Lively's "shy" demeanor.

"I've only ever found her to be completely generous and kind," Lively told the \*Los Angeles Times\*, underscoring Stewart's innate ability to foster connections among individuals.
