



Sabrina Carpenter responds to troll after topping the charts

Description

Singer Sabrina Carpenter's song "Please Please Please" has reached number 1 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart. On Monday, Carpenter **celebrated** the achievement by sharing a picture of the **announcement** alongside a mean comment about the song, expressing her **gratitude**.

This success **surpasses** her previous single, "Espresso," which peaked at number 3. "Please Please Please" is Carpenter's first song to hit the top spot. To mark this milestone, she announced a new **album**, "Short n' Sweet," set to release on August 23, including both hit singles.

The music video for "Please Please Please" features actor Barry Keoghan, Carpenter's boyfriend, and depicts them as a couple meeting in a prison. The couple **confirmed** their relationship at a post-Oscars party in March.
