



Safety Neglected: Toddler Trapped in Tesla Due to Dead Battery during Heat Wave, Expert Criticizes Tesla's Priorities

Description

A 20-month-old girl from Arizona had a harrowing experience when she was locked inside a Tesla Model Y after the car's battery died. The girl's grandmother had strapped her into her car seat for a trip to the Phoenix Zoo, but when the car's battery died, she found herself unable to open the doors. In a panic, she called 911, and firefighters had to break open the door with an ax to rescue the toddler, who was scared and crying during the ordeal.

Experts warned that a child trapped in a hot car in Arizona could be in danger within 15 minutes, and many do not survive after 30 minutes. The grandmother expressed her **frustration** with the firefighters' **initial reluctance** to break into the Tesla, but they eventually managed to **rescue** the child.
