



Selecting 36 Favourites for Bristol in the C2 Level NASCAR Fantasy Game

Description

The high-octane, thrilling pursuit dubbed NASCAR.com's 36 for 36 perpetuates at Bristol Motor Speedway, a formidable racing track that has been the theatre of numerous strategic battles in the past. The playing field, characterized by 36 races and 36 full-time Charter cars, bestows upon our participants the license to elect one vehicle per race. Nevertheless, there is a subtle yet significant caveat: once they have elected a vehicle, they are prohibited from selecting it again for the remaining duration of the 36-race season. This intrigues as it becomes a survivor pool, implying every vehicle gets precisely a single selection.

This intriguing journey is further enlivened by our panel of strategists compendiously made up of Dustin Albino, emanating from Jayski, along with Steve Luvender and Cameron Richardson from NASCAR.com. These experts embark upon this tantalizing, season-long excursion to outwit each other and claim the crown of being the most astute in selection.

An added dash of excitement is the fourth "community" 36 for 36 choice each week, the result of a collective decision by intensive fan polls on the r/NASCAR subreddit.

This is followed by Dustin Albino with an aggregate of 93 points, and the r/NASCAR Community, trailing behind with an overall score of 89. As the series transits to its fifth race, we focus our attention on Bristol, peripheral events have resulted in a tightening of our 36 for 36 rankings, with three out of four decision-makers making an entry into the top-10 selections. Steve Luvender, inspired by the momentum of Brad Keselowski's recent success, has elected Keselowski as his choice for Bristol. Keselowski's past victories at Bristol and his top performances at Phoenix give Steve a fighting chance against his competitors.

Cameron Richardson has, interestingly, chosen the same racer as Albino, Carson Hocevar for this race.



Richardson justified his decision by pointing at Hocevar's previous performance at Bristol and his consistent top-15 finishes at this high-stakes race.

Finally, the r/NASCAR Community has put their faith in Ricky Stenhouse Jr., due to his proven track record at Bristol.
