## Skai Jackson arrested for battery in boyfriend brawl.

### Description

Last week, Disney Channel star Skai Jackson, known for her roles in "Jessie" and "Bunk'd," was arrested for domestic battery after a dispute with her boyfriend at Universal CityWalk in Hollywood, California. Security witnessed the couple fighting and called the police when they saw Jackson push her boyfriend multiple times. Surveillance footage confirmed the allegations, showing her pushing him twice.

Despite the evidence, both Jackson and her boyfriend denied any physical altercation, claiming to be happily engaged and expecting a baby. Jackson was arrested for misdemeanor domestic battery, but was later cited and released. The case will be reviewed by the LA County District Attorney's Office to determine if charges will be pressed.
