



Sony Denies Claims of Anger Towards Naughty Dog Misquote

Description

A recent exchange between Bloomberg journalist Jason Schreier and a reader has led to misleading claims on social media, suggesting that Sony is "angry" with its game studio, Naughty Dog. This incident began on the platform Bluesky when Schreier shared an exclusive report concerning another game developer, Bungie.

In the discussion, Schreier addressed concerns over the financial aspects of developing new video games, particularly pointing out the high costs associated with game development today. He expressed that Sony was cautious about the budget for a new massive multiplayer online (MMO) shooter, especially after investing heavily in Naughty Dog's projects, which have taken considerable time and resources.

Misinterpretations of Schreier's comments spread rapidly online. One Reddit user misrepresented his remarks, claiming that Sony was unhappy specifically with Naughty Dog due to a lack of new game releases for the PlayStation 5. This sparked a wave of commentary across social media, although Schreier later clarified that his words were taken out of context.

In an effort to address the misunderstandings, Schreier noted that his original point was about costs, not about Sony's feelings towards Naughty Dog. He emphasised that while Sony is concerned about the escalating time and budgets involved in game development, it does not equate to direct anger towards the studio.

This incident highlights the challenges of misinformation on social media. As discussions about game development continue, clarity and accurate representation become increasingly important.
