



SpaceX and Boeing Target Monday for Starlink and Starliner Doubleheader

Description

A high-profile space launch doubleheader could take place within 11 hours or fewer at Cape Canaveral Space Force Station, as SpaceX targets a Monday morning mission. Although not officially announced by SpaceX, navigational warnings suggest a Starlink launch window will open from 11:34 a.m. to 4:05 p.m. EDT on Monday. This will be followed by the liftoff of the first crewed Boeing Starliner spacecraft at 10:34 p.m. for NASA's Commercial Crew Program. Favorable weather conditions are expected for both launches.

NASA astronauts Suni Williams and Butch Wilmore will embark on a test-flight journey to the International Space Station aboard the Starliner atop a United Launch Alliance Atlas V rocket. This marks only the sixth time NASA has flown a new crewed transportation spacecraft, making it a significant milestone in space exploration history.

Following liftoff, Williams and Wilmore are scheduled to dock with the ISS at 12:46 a.m. Wednesday. The astronauts will spend over a week aboard the ISS conducting various activities to test the spacecraft's capabilities for future missions.
