



Springsteen Condemns Trump's Administration as 'Treasonous' in England

Description

Bruce Springsteen inaugurated his "Land of Hope and Dreams" tour in Manchester, England, with a vehement denunciation of President Trump, articulating grave concerns regarding his administration's perceived infractions against civil rights and labor rights, as well as its abandonment of traditional allies in favor of authoritarian regimes.

For a public figure known for his liberal stance, Springsteen's remarks were particularly incisive, especially when juxtaposed with the hesitance exhibited by some artists to confront Trump directly in recent years. Unlike the fervent denunciations rampant in 2017, following Trump's ascendance to the presidency, Springsteen's bold assertions stand out as a vital protest in our current sociopolitical climate.

During the performance, Springsteen, now 75, explicitly critiqued Trump in remarks preceding his songs "Land of Hope and Dreams," "House of a Thousand Guitars," and "My City of Ruins." He subsequently disseminated a **transcript** of his commentary on his official website and shared a **video** of the remarks on YouTube, further amplifying his voice.

"The formidable E Street Band unites tonight to invoke the potent influence of art, music, and rock 'n' roll in these precarious times," he declared. "In my homeland—the America I cherish and have celebrated as a symbol of hope and liberty for two and a half centuries—power resides presently with a corrupt, incompetent, and treasonous administration."

The audience erupted in tumultuous cheers as Springsteen recounted a litany of grievances, accusing the administration of reveling in the suffering inflicted upon dedicated American workers. He lamented, "They are systematically dismantling historic civil rights statutes that have fostered a more equitable and diverse society. They abandon our esteemed allies, aligning instead with despots while forsaking those yearning for freedom."

Springsteen's words resonate powerfully, illuminating an urgent call to action and ethical responsibility, manifesting as a poignant reminder of the artist's role in speaking truth to power.
