



Stardew Valley 1.6 Update Proves Long-Standing Fan Theory Is Accurate

Description

Stardew Valley fans are feeling **vindicated** after the game's creator, Eric Barone, confirmed a **peculiar** fact: harvesting crops from left to right is faster than from right to left. This strange bug, present since the game's launch in 2016, will finally be addressed. Fans have been eagerly awaiting since 2022 for the potential **amelioration** of this issue in the upcoming 1.6 update, slated for release on March 19 for PCs. The update is set to introduce new content and make the game simpler to modify, besides fixing old bugs. Barone has been actively sharing patch notes and snippets to whet the **appetite** of fans counting down to its arrival. The change confirms what many players have **intuited** over the years.
