Abbott Shares Go Up After Baby Formula Ruling

Abbott Laboratories (ABT) shares went up on Friday. This happened after a jury said the company is not responsible for a boy's sickness. The boy had a serious problem called necrotizing enterocolitis (NEC). This can hurt a baby's intestines.

The court ruled in favor of Abbott and Reckitt Benckiser, another company that makes baby formula. Abbott said the ruling shows that their products are safe.

This is the first win for these companies in court about NEC after losing two big cases earlier this year.

Now, Abbott shares are up more than 5% in early trading.
