



Surge in food delivery demand also leads to increase in complaints

Description

The rise in demand for fast food delivery has led to a surge in couriers zipping around big cities on scooters and motorcycles, causing concern among officials. Boston, New York, and Washington, D.C., have started cracking down on delivery companies for illegal operations, such as driving unregistered vehicles and breaking traffic laws. The delivery companies have promised to work with city officials to ensure their drivers operate safely and legally.

The delivery companies have pledged to cooperate with officials and neighborhood advocates to address these concerns.
