Line judges will no longer feature at Wimbledon from next year

David Bayliss, a former Wimbledon line judge, shares his thoughts on the decision to replace human line judges with technology for "maximum accuracy".

Bayliss, who served for 22 years at Wimbledon, recalls memorable moments and jokes about being hit by a ball at high speed.

While he acknowledges the logic behind the change, some wonder if it will impact the drama and human element of the game that fans enjoy.

Technology like Hawk-Eye has been integral to tennis, and other major tournaments have also adopted electronic systems, following a trend set by Wimbledon.

Bayliss highlights the trust players have in electronic line-calling systems, emphasizing their accuracy over human judgment.
