

The Global IT Outage Impact Explained

Getty Images A Gemeasuring the blood pressure of a woman in a doctor's office GP services in England and Northern Ireland were severely disrupted due to IT problems caused by a software update by CrowdStrike.

GPs were unable to treat patients, planes couldn't take off, and small businesses lost money. The full impact of the global IT outage on 19 July is still emerging.

A faulty software update by CrowdStrike affected up to eight and half million computers worldwide using Microsoft systems. CrowdStrike's senior manager will address the US Congress to explain the incident.

Dr. David Wrigley, a GP for 22 years, highlighted delays in cancer treatments due to the outage. He emphasized the need for stronger support from NHS England and the UK government.

Dr. David Wrigley calls for more support for GPs during such crises.

The IT outage also impacted Northern Ireland, where 75% of GPs use the affected system. The Department of Health is working on strengthening continuity plans.

Prof. Kamila Hawthorne stressed the importance of safeguards for such situations. Meanwhile, airports worldwide and small businesses like Dawn's and Hannah's suffered losses.
