



The Rolling Stones deliver a hit-packed performance at Cleveland Browns Stadium

Description

The Rolling Stones, a **legendary** rock band, brought their Hackney Diamonds **Tour** to Cleveland Browns Stadium on Saturday night, marking only their second visit to the city this century. **Despite** their advanced age, the core trio of Mick Jagger, Keith Richards, and Ronnie Wood, who recently turned 77, rocked the stage for over two hours, treating fans to a mix of their classic hits and new songs from their latest album.
