



Tony Awards 2024: Major Wins for *Stereophonic*, *Merrily We Roll Along*, and *The Outsiders*

Description

The recently concluded 77th annual Tony Awards made headlines with major wins for shows such as *Stereophonic*, *Merrily We Roll Along*, and *The Outsiders*, as well as actors Jeremy Strong and Daniel Radcliffe. *Stereophonic*, the most nominated play in Tonys history, took home five awards, including best play.
