

The game comprises of Abeyance Realms, designed to cater to peaceful exploration and base building. These realms, fundamentally lower in difficulty than those shaped by Nightingale's Antiquarian cards, proffer their exclusive benefits. The player's preference dictates the selection of the initial Abeyance, therefore, the succeeding guide seeks to illuminate the pros and cons of each choice.

Prudent Preferences: Best Abeyance Realms in Nightingale





Commencing the role of a novice Realmwalker, Puck facilitates the selection from one of the three Abeyance Realms after the tutorial conclusion. This pivotal decision shapes your initial gameplay experience, with varying difficulty levels and the range of enemies and resources encountered within the realms.

- **Forest** — The most benign Abeyance Realm. Abundant resources such as Wood and Stone, accompanied by terrestrial fauna including wolves, deer, and boars roaming the wilderness, provide the players with an immersive yet undemanding experience.
- **Desert** — A realm posing survival challenges. Resources like Wood and Plant Fibers are sparse, scattered across oases, and the blistering desert sun relentlessly depletes the player's energy.
- **Swamp** — An intermediate difficulty realm. Although resources are profuse, the fantastical fauna tends to be hostile. The prevalence of poisonous mires adds another layer of difficulty.

Note: An Abeyance Realm is characterized by its low-risk gameplay. However, this definition is not restricted to a specific type of biome. With the utilization of various Realm Cards like Antiquarian, Astrolabe, Hunt, etc., on a portal machine, players can explore more complex versions of each biome.

For those treading the uncharted territory of the survival crafting genre, embarking on your journey within the Forest realm is highly recommended. This seemingly serene environment offers an ideal introduction to the game's core dynamics like repairing, crafting, and exploration. Moreover, the Carnutes — ethereal deer-like creatures that replenish forests — make these realms perfect for base building.

On the other hand, seasoned survivalists might prefer delving into the Swamp realm. Although the fauna here is more hostile, the richness of valuable mining resources is unparalleled to those found in Forest realms.

It is ill-advised to initiate your journey in the Desert realm. The excruciating heat burdening early game exploration, coupled with a scarcity of Wood supplies, results in hardship during base construction. Furthermore, the propitiousness of flora and fauna spawns in the world could mean the difference between life and death due to starvation.
