

Tragic Onstage Passing: Actor Julien Arnold Dies during 'A Christmas Carol' Performance

Description

Julien Arnold, a 60-year-old Canadian actor, tragically passed away during a performance of "A Christmas Carol" due to a sudden medical emergency. The exact cause of his death remains unknown, but paramedics arrived promptly at the Citadel Theater in Edmonton, Canada, around 8:28 p.m. Despite their efforts to resuscitate him, Arnold died at the scene, according to the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation.

Arnold was portraying the dual roles of Marley and Mr. Fezziwig in this classic adaptation of Charles Dickens' beloved novel. His dedication to the craft was evident in his performances, and he was well-respected within the local theater community.

In a heartfelt statement shared on social media, the Citadel Theater mourned the loss of Arnold, describing him as "a beloved actor and dear friend," as well as a "cherished member" of Edmonton's artistic scene. Notably, he was a founding member of Free Will Players, a theater company renowned for its annual Shakespeare festival, and had been an integral part of Edmonton's cultural landscape for many years.

The theater also announced that the remaining performances of "A Christmas Carol" would be dedicated to his memory, emphasizing the profound impact he had on both his colleagues and audiences alike. "Julien's passing is a significant loss to his family, friends, and the entire Edmonton community he cherished," the theater remarked.

In response to their sudden loss, a GoFundMe campaign has been initiated to support Arnold's family, currently having raised approximately \$42,000.
