
Trump shares fake Taylor Swift endorsement; Santos awaiting court decision

Donald Trump has sparked controversy by resorting to artificial intelligence to promote a false "Swifties for Trump" campaign, erroneously asserting that Taylor Swift, a prominent singer-songwriter and Democrat, is endorsing his presidential candidacy.

Meanwhile, George Santos, a former New York Republican congressman and Trump supporter embroiled in scandal, is reportedly on the verge of accepting a plea bargain in his federal criminal case to avoid a trial.

In a recent cautionary statement, Trump was advised by Lindsey Graham, a key figure in the MAGA movement, that he risks losing the upcoming presidential election to Kamala Harris if he continues to engage in provocative behavior by attacking his Democratic opponent personally rather than providing substantive policy critiques.

Despite these warnings, Trump has shown little inclination for change, recently claiming at a rally in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, that he is more attractive than Harris and deriding her laughter as "crazy."

Furthermore, Trump's running mate, JD Vance, made a puzzling comparison between Harris and the infamous sex offender Jeffrey Epstein, a move likely to backfire given Trump's previous praise of Epstein as a "great guy" and their documented interactions.
