

Upcoming iPhone: Kickoff for Apple's Exciting Launch Wave

<u>Apple</u> is reportedly poised to unveil over 20 new products this year, continuing its trend of growth driven by services.

Expectations are high for updated Mac Studio, Mac Pro, and Apple TV 4K, as well as new AirPods, Apple Watch, and Vision Pro headset within the first half of 2025.

As Apple nears a \$4 trillion valuation, bolstered by advancements in artificial intelligence, the company's stock surged last year amid increasing investor interest in Al-enhanced devices. This shift signifies a bold new direction for Apple in the tech landscape.
